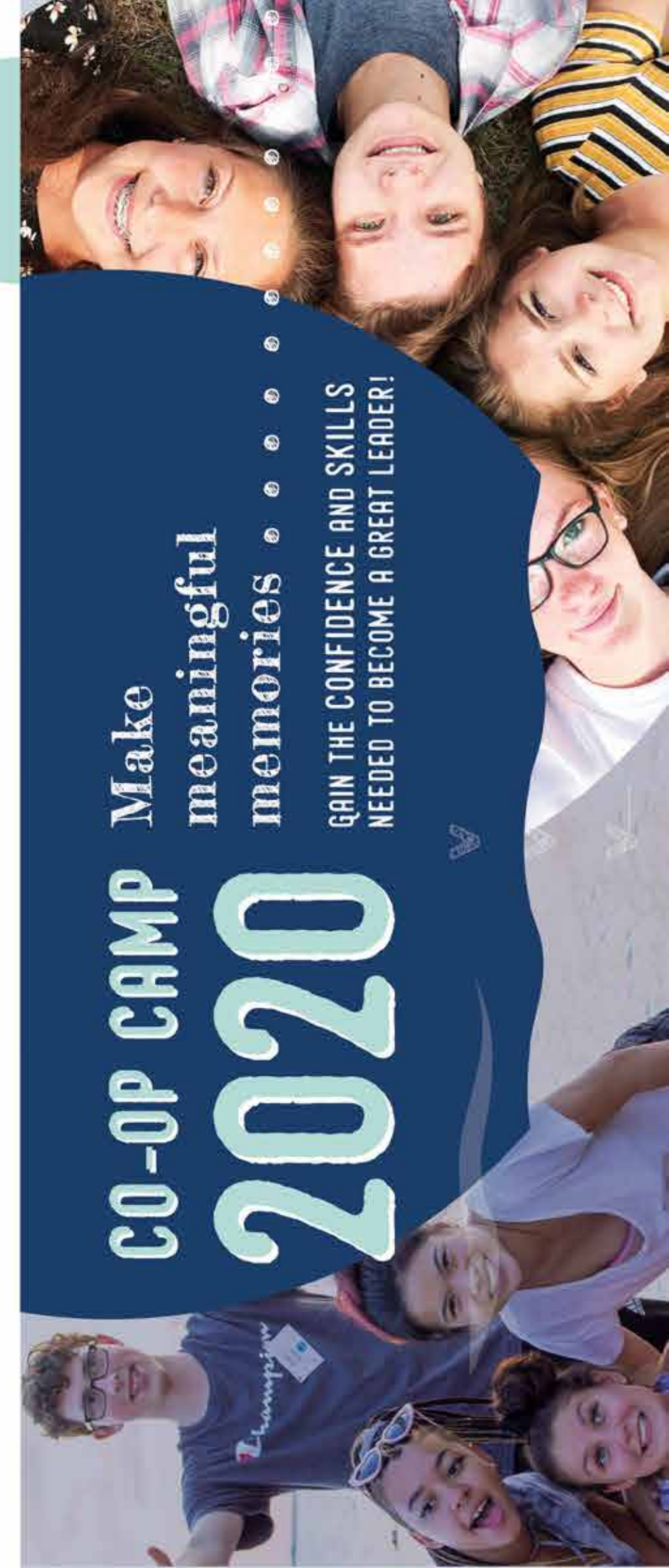

OBTAINING SPONSORSHIP

REGISTRATION

If you are **12 or 13** before December 31, 2020 and:

- > have never attended Co-op Camp, register at the **Junior level** or
- > have completed the Junior level, register at the **Introductory level**.

If you are **14 or 15** before December 31, 2020 and:

- > have never attended Co-op Camp, register at the **Introductory level** or
- > have completed the Introductory level, register at the **Intermediate level**.

If you are **16 to 18** before December 31, 2020 and:

- > have never attended Co-op Camp, register at the **Intermediate level** or
- > have completed the Intermediate level, you will receive a personal invitation to attend our special Graduate level.

If you have completed our Graduate level in recent years, you will receive a personal invitation to attend our amazing Senior Graduate level!

Registration deadline is two weeks prior to the commencement of each camp, but REGISTER NOW to get your first choice!

- **Once accepted, your parent/guardian will receive a confirmation email.**
Complete details will be emailed three weeks prior to your camp.
- At least \$150 of your registration fee must accompany your registration form as a deposit. This deposit holds your spot in Co-op Camp. **Until this fee is submitted, SCYP cannot guarantee a spot in Co-op Camp.**
- **Your deposit (\$150) is non-refundable.**
Cancellation must be made two weeks before camp to avoid forfeiting the remainder of your deposit/registration fee.
- If you want to attend camp but are unable to pay some or all of the registration fee, please contact us, we will try to **help you find additional sponsorship.**
